NPO EXCHANGE PROGRAM

The NPO Exchange Program is one of the newest initiatives of Partners Albania, following several years of work in supporting the strengthening of the NPO sector, building inter-sectorial dialogue for the involvement of NPOs in policy-making and decision-making processes.

The program contributes to increasing the capacities of newly established organizations, operating in various cities across the country, enabling improved access to information and collaboration with other important organizations and institutions in the country."

Participants in the program are selected through an open call for expressions of interest. The program is a combination of onsite visits to NPOs, public and private institutions, discussion sessions with experts from different fields, as well as mentoring sessions to implement the acquired knowledge into practice.

This brochure presents a series of testimonials from participants in the programs organized during 2023 - 2024. Partners Albania plans to organize additional programs as part of a long-term intervention in support the civil society sector.















Samira Pikuli

Frequently, the everevolving nature of the social issue we strive to address, coupled with the financial limitations, leads organizations to approach the introduction of fee-based services with caution. However, by fostering a collaborative environment for the exchange of ideas and experiences, we are better positioned to recognize the opportunities within our operational context. This facilitates the encouragement of creative thinking for innovative solutions and a more pragmatic understanding of the risks that necessitate careful management. Above all, such interactions bolster our collective courage to embark on new initiatives regarding these services. We extend our sincere gratitude to Partners Albania for its steadfast efforts in creating an enabling environment wherein non-profit organizations can be strengthened and sustainable.
